**SEMINAR DISCUSSES NEW PROCEDURE AS
ALTERNATIVE TO HYSTERECTOMY**

Columbia, MD – Kimberly Moran Turner, MD invites the public to a women’s health seminar, **“New Treatment Options for Heavy Periods, PMS & Menopause.”**

Dr. Turner will discuss a new treatment option—cryoablation, which is an in-office procedure that eliminates the uterine lining with minimal risk and pain, and has brought relief from symptoms to thousands of women around the country. The new procedure is an alternative to a hysterectomy, which previously was the only relief from severe symptoms. More than 28 million women around the world are affected by excessive bleeding, a condition called menorrhagia.
